To safely prevent accidents, Swiss companies are obligated in accordance with SNR 462638 (DIN VDE 0701 / 0702) to inspect their electrical working equipment regularly and to document these inspections.

WHICH DEVICES ARE AFFECTED AND HOW OFTEN DO THEY NEED TO BE INSPECTED?

All electrically powered devices such as extension cables, power cords for laptops, docking stations, standing lamps and monitors etc. are affected.

The recommended inspection interval depends on factors including application type, place and frequency. We recommend:

- 1-year inspection cycle in workshops, industry, laboratories and commercial kitchens
- > 2-year inspection cycle in offices and hotels



OUR APPROACH TO INSPECTIONS

1. Initial inspection of all existing devices

- > All devices are recorded and equipped with a barcode.
- > Following inspection, each device is given an individual inspection sticker.
- > All inspected devices are documented.

2. Recurring periodic inspections

- > The devices are inspected according to an agreed inspection cycle.
- > Following inspection, the inspection sticker is updated for each device.
- > All inspected devices are documented.
