Sodexo launches Kitchen Works Co.

The first Kitchen Works Co. restaurant opened this week at Toyota's Burnaston manufacturing site in Derby, the home of the new Corolla launched in January 2019.

Kitchen Works Co. has been developed using the latest consumer insight and offers nutritious and tasty food in a welcoming environment providing a dining space where colleagues can refuel, recharge and regroup away from their day-to-day tasks.

Sodexo's own research among automotive workers in 2017 revealed that 64% were aware that their performance and productivity was directly related to what and when they eat and 68% regard the quality of food provided as important, but only 32% felt well-catered for by their organisation.

Kitchen Works Co. addresses this, delivering a wide range of meal options featuring global cuisine, plant-based dishes ideal for those following a vegetarian and flexitarian diet and a new grab-and-go range. Traditional favourites such as sausage and mash will be served alongside hero dishes such as Chipotle Glazed Belly Pork with Gratin Potatoes & Sautéed Courgettes and Chicken Katsu curry and rice.

At Burnaston, Sodexo invested in the refurbishment of the main restaurant to create the new Kitchen Works Co. The new restaurant, which caters for the 2,600 workers, includes a new and improved layout, digital screens and new furniture as well as a brand new menu which also includes using rescued fruit and vegetables as part of Sodexo's Wasteful to Tasteful initiative.

Toyota and Sodexo share a common goal to help employees improve their health and well-being at work, and at home as well as a strong commitment to sustainability.
